



Proposed Balcorrach Wood: Key landscape design considerations

Maintain integrity of drumlins by establishing species and coupe pattern to reflect landform

> Area of wetland sand shallow valley – use open space, shrubs and wet woodland as appropriate to create different character

Potential for policy woodland to link with key characteristic of Glazert valley

Consider views from and immediate setting of adjacent houses and farms

> Indicative upper margin should reflect landform, maintain views from Crow Road and not venture onto steeper slopes. The fenceline should be located below the sightline as visible from the Crow Road, along the break in slope


Site boundary




Balcorrach Wood
